

#### **The Basics**

### **Open Calls for Pilot Projects: Basic Description**

#### Main objective:


- o (a) contribute tools and services to the European Language Grid, increase coverage of ELG
- (b) develop applications using language technologies available in the ELG
- Results shall be made available through the ELG
- The pilots will be based on a **four-phase process**, consisting of the following activities:
- 1. Open call
- 2. Experiment
- 3. Integration
- 4. Dissemination

### **Open Calls: Main Parameters**

- Maximum amount per pilot project: €200.000
- Approx. €2.000.000 to be distributed in total
- Budget part of the project proposal standard Horizon 2020 budget criteria
- lump sum principle
- Three payments:
- 1. 50 % after signing the contract
- 2. 35 % after demonstrating the results after the end of activity (2) (Experiment)
- 3. 15 % after completing the activities (3) (Integration) and (4) (Dissemination)

## **Eligibility**

### Eligibility

- Beneficiaries
- Only SMEs and research organizations (non-SMEs, i.e., large enterprises or non-research organizations are not eligible, as are ELG partners)
- Individual projects one organization per project only
- The **definition of SME** is the one by the Commission Recommendation 2003/361/EC
- Up to two proposals per applicant will be accepted for evaluation
- Resubmission is allowed in the second call if the project was not accepted in the first one
- No double funding is allowed between the project ELG and/or any other incubator or similar scheme for FSTP
- Countries Horizon2020 eligible countries

### Proposals: Preparation, submission, evaluation

### **Proposals: Preparation, Submission, Evaluation**

- Lightweight procedure
- **Short** proposal (approx. 5 10 pages, incl. formalities)
- Two-months submission period
- We expect to use **Fundingbox** as a tool for submission of project proposals
- Assistance to applicants (will be available on the open calls website)
  - Guidance & Training Materials
  - Promotion videos
  - E-mail helpdesk & FAQ page



### Open Calls: Preparation, Submission & Evaluation of Proposals

#### Evaluation criteria:

- a) Objective fit
- b) Technical approach
- c) Business, Integration and Dissemination ("BID") plan
- d) Budget adequacy
- e) Team
- Each project will get one member of the Pilot Board, shepherding it through the process
- Pilot Board will rank all submitted projects, set cutoff
- Call 1: 6-15 projects
- Call 2: 4-15 projects, up to a maximum funding available (min. 30 % of funding for Call 2)

#### **Summary**

- Two open calls for demonstrator/integration projects
  - 1st Call: March 2020, 2nd Call: September 2020
- These pilot projects shall
  - broaden ELG's portfolio of language technologies and data sets
    - E.g., develop missing services, data sets or solutions for underrepresented languages
  - demonstrate the usefulness of the European Language Grid as a technology platform
- Amounts awarded: up to 200,000€ per project
- Duration: 9-12 months
- Eligibility: SMEs, Research Organizations
