- Founded in 2010 by T4ME, later supported by CRACKER, now ELG and ELE
 - 60 members from 34 countries
 - META: Multilingual Europe Technology Alliance with "free" membership
 - 900+ members from 68 countries
- META-FORUM
 - This conference since 2010, now the 11th META-FORUM
- Goal(s)
 - Connect the LT community: research, business, public administrations
 - Vision for the LT community: Strategic Agenda(s) now within ELE

Between META-FORUM 2021 and today ...

- Language Technology projects in Europe
 - ELG completed Open Calls for pilot projects (15 projects funded)
 - ELE European Language Equality PP/PA (2021-2022)
 - Strategic Research and Innovation Agenda for LT up to 2030 (almost done)
 - To be continued by ELE 2 (2022-23)
 - Cooperation with ongoing or recently completed LT/NLP projects:
 - **ELITR** automatic interpreting
 - Bergamot in-browser MT,
 - Comprise voice-enabled services,
 - EMBEDDIA Cross-lingual embeddings,
 - Prêt-à-LLOD Linguistic Linked Open Data,
 - Gourmet MT for low-resourced languages
 - Language Technology represented in the ongoing Humane-AI Net center of excellence (2020-2023)
