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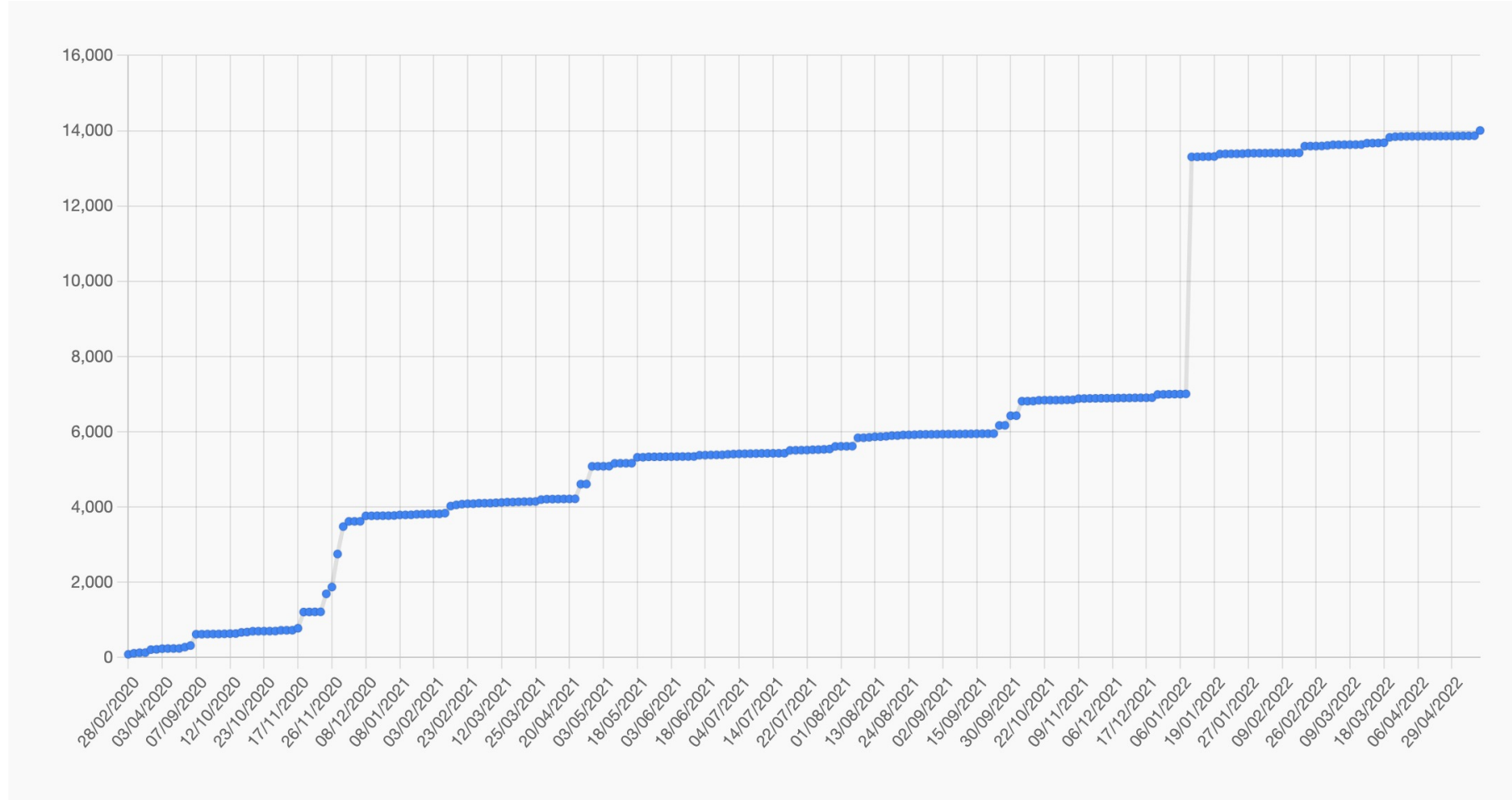

ELG is growing up



- ~12,300 tools & resources
- ~1,700 projects & organizations

ELG is growing up

- Project started in 2019 with just a few hundred services & resources from project partners
- From mid-2020 this was expanded by the pilot projects, and harvesting metadata from other repositories
- Now seeing other projects actively choosing ELG as a dissemination channel for many reasons
 - Visibility
 - Standardisation
 - Tap into ELG technical knowledge & best practice
- This session aims to showcase some particularly interesting examples, both of resource & services contributed *to* ELG and external tools that *use* services that ELG offers

- Machine Translation

 - ... with public data: OPUS-MT – Jörg Tiedemann & Tommi Nieminen, Univ. of Helsinki (Finland)
- Third parties adopting ELG
 - Microservices At Your Service – Tiina Lindh-Knuutila, Lingsoft (Finland)

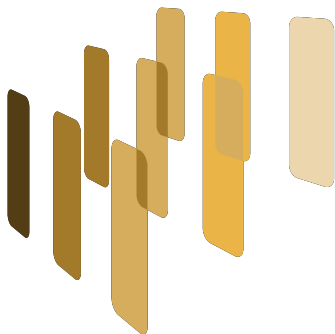

Summary

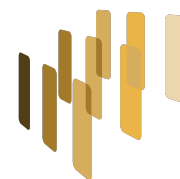
- ELG supports a wide variety of different resource and service types
