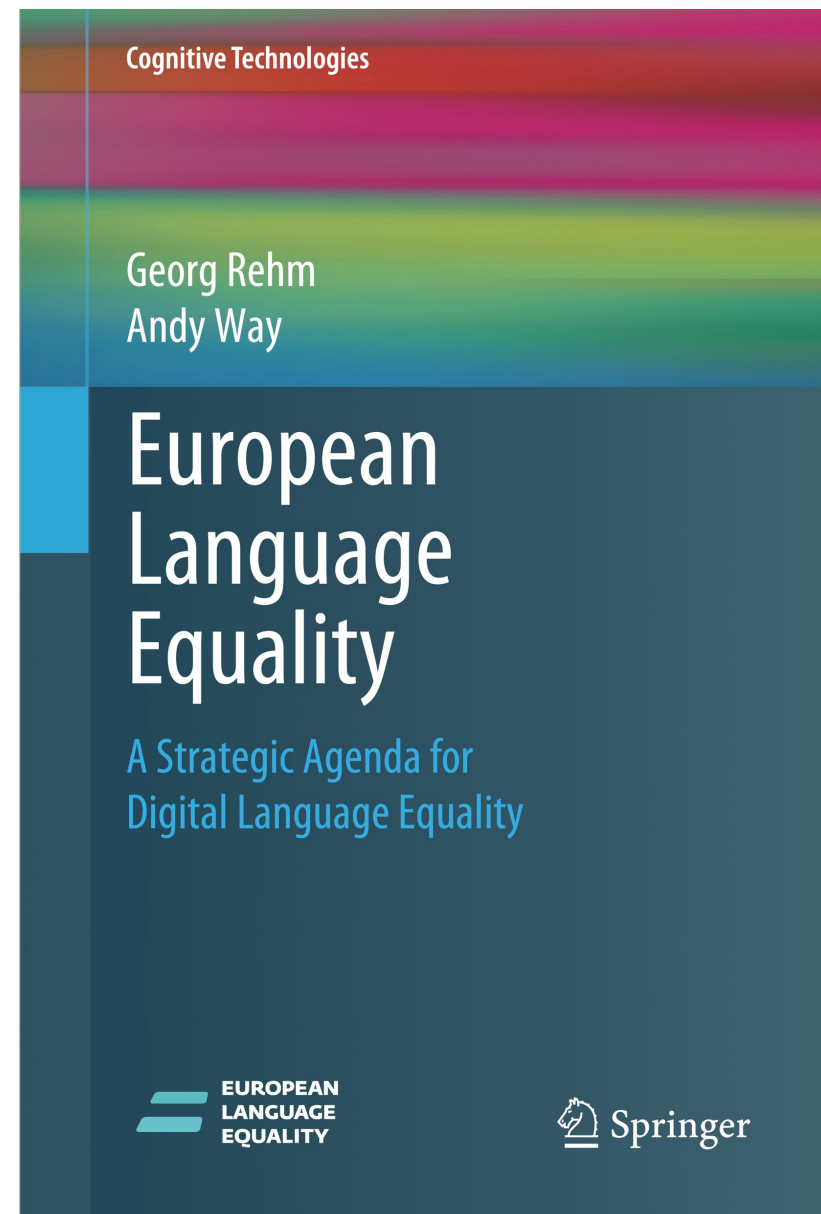

European Language Grid Book



- ELG book almost ready – will be submitted to the publisher in June/July 2022
- ELE book to follow in the second half of 2022
- Both books will be Open Access
- The ELG book has 29 chapters, divided into four parts (approx. 400 pages in total)

New Projects related to the European Language Grid 1/4

OpenGPT-X



- Runtime: January 2022 until December 2024
- Funder: German Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Climate Action (BMWK)
- Goal: Development of large language models (DE, EN, other EU languages) and related smart services, to be made available via Gaia-X
- Relation to ELG: Integration of the ELG platform into the emerging Gaia-X ecosystem; use of ELG data for training language models; sharing of project results through ELG

New Projects related to the European Language Grid 2/4

NFDI4DataScience and AI



- Runtime: October 2021 until September 2026
- Funder: Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft (DFG)
- NFDI: Nationale Forschungsdateninfrastruktur (National Research Data Infrastructure)
- Goal: Development of digital tools and infrastructures that support Data Science and AI research in general including neighbouring communities (LT, NLP, Semantic Web etc.)
- Relation to ELG: Integration of the ELG platform into the emerging NFDI ecosystem; making use of ELG services and resources for shared tasks

New Projects related to the European Language Grid 3/4

N.N. 1

- Status: *Proposal accepted for funding, GA not fully signed yet*
- Runtime: October 2022 until September 2025
- Funder: EU – Horizon Europe
- Goal: Development of a toolbox for data processing, handling, curation for expanding digital value creation in European Data Spaces
- Relation to ELG: Creation of multiple links with the ELG platform and initiative

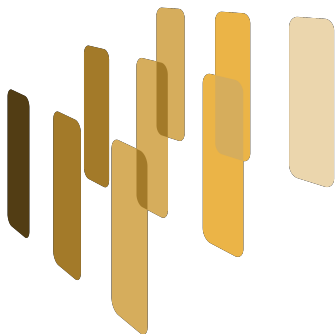

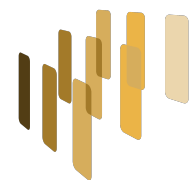
