D3.1 Main Findings

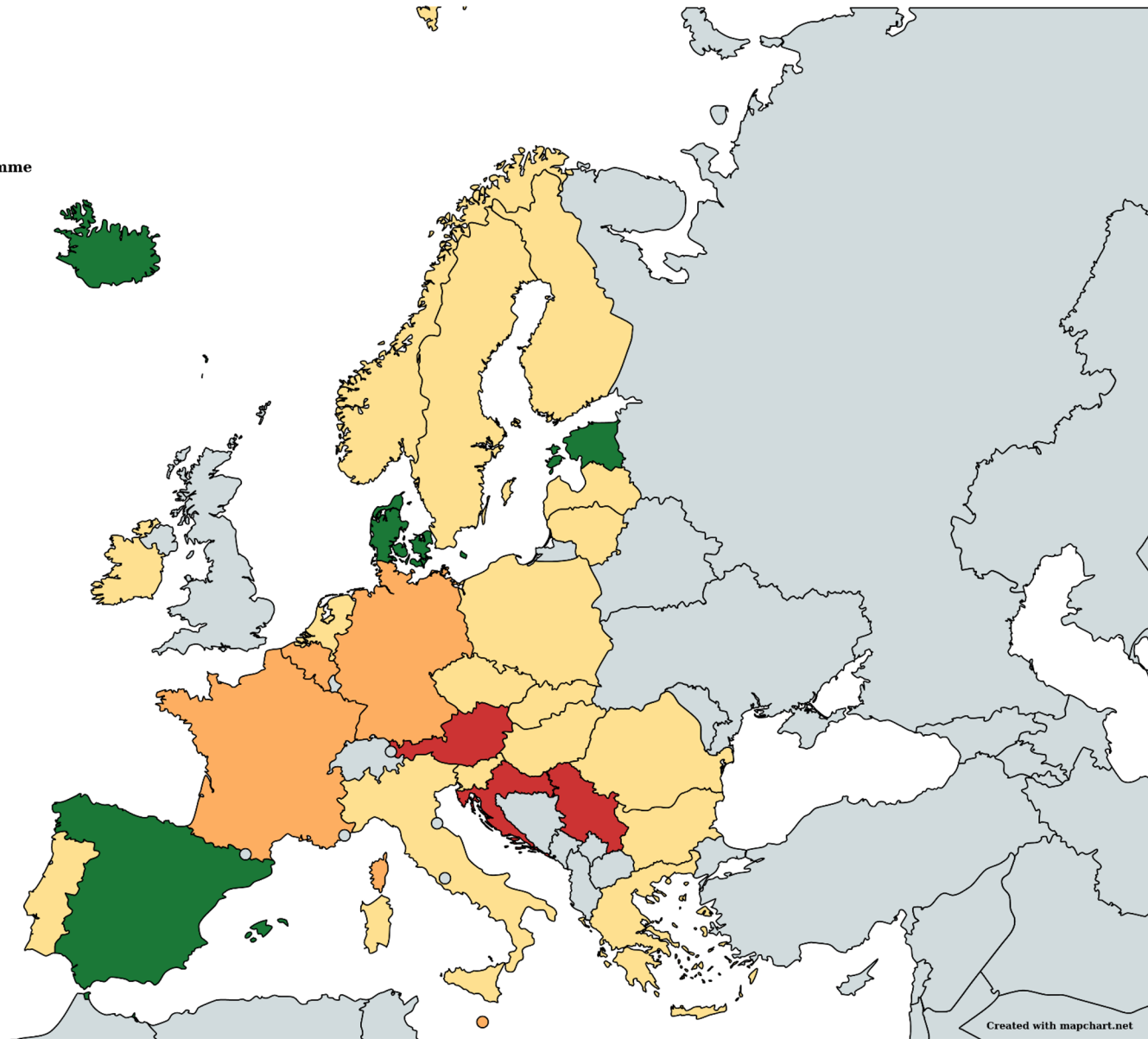
- Together with **Vision** and **Robotics**, **LT** is one of the three core application areas within **AI**.
- Current LT allows many advanced applications, **unthinkable** only a few years ago.
- Even more **exciting results** in the near future.
- LT is outlined as one of the **most relevant** technologies for society.
- LT is one of the most important AI application areas with a fast growing **economic impact**.
- However, LT is **not equally** developed for all European languages.
- **Very few** dedicated nationally financed programmes addressing LT.

National LT/AI strategies in Europe

All countries surveyed have a **national AI strategy**

- *Croatia?*
- **No LT-related funding at all**
 - Austria, Serbia
- **Limited LT-related funding**
 - Bulgaria, Czechia, Finland, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Lux., Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Sweden.
- **Funding for LT through AI**
 - Belgium, France, Germany and Malta
- **Dedicated LT programmes**
 - Denmark, Estonia, Iceland and Spain

- None at all
- Some funding
- Funding through AI
- Dedicated LT programme
